Researchers at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) are looking for healthy volunteers to take part in a research study using a brain imaging technique called Positron Emission Tomography (PET).

The study will evaluate a new PET marker that will help us learn more about a chemical system in the brain called the serotonin system. This new marker may help develop new drugs to treat serotonin imbalances.

Interested individuals need to pass a medical examination and screening interview.

You may qualify to participate if you are:

- male or female
- aged 18 to 50 and in good health
- not regularly taking medications
- a non-smoker

Study participants will be compensated for their time.
